INTRODUCTION

The EITC/Free Tax Preparation program is funded by the Louisiana Department of Social Services to help eligible taxpayers who work, but don't earn high incomes. The EITC delivers billions of dollars to millions of low-to moderate income taxpayers—many of whom rely on the credit to lift them above the poverty line.

Congress enacted the EITC in 1975 to offset the burden of Social Security taxes on low-to moderate income taxpayers, supplement wages and make employment more attractive than welfare. Since then, the EITC has been changed many times, increasing the scope and impact of the credit.

The EITC has no effect on certain welfare benefits. In most cases, EITC payments will not be used to determine eligibility for Medicaid, supplemental security income (SSI), food stamps, low-income housing, or most Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) payments.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- The taxpayer cannot be a qualifying child of another person.
- If the taxpayer does not have a qualifying child, he or she must:
 - Be age 25 but under 65 at the end of the year,
 - Live in the US for more than half of the tax year, and
 - Not qualify as a dependent of another person.
- The taxpayer, his or her spouse (filing jointly) and any qualifying child listed on Schedule EIC must have valid social security numbers issued by the Social Security Administration.
- The taxpayer must have earned income from employment or from self-employment.
- The taxpayer must be a U.S. citizen or resident alien all year, or a nonresident alien married to a U.S. citizen or resident alien and filing a joint return.
