St. James Parish Government, Department of Human Resources, CAA Announces its Quarterly Food Bank Distribution Schedule

St. James Parish Government, Department of Human Resources, Community Action Agency along with the Greater Baton Rouge Food Bank will distribute commodities to eligible families and individuals in St. James Parish on Monday, February 27, 2023, and Tuesday, February 28, 2023. Commodities will be distributed via drive through on a first come, first served basis to all registered applicants. Identification will be required to pick up commodities. To be eligible to receive commodities, an individual must be a resident of St. James Parish and meet the income guidelines below.

Individuals who have not pre-registered but would like to apply will be considered as walk-ins. Walk-ins will be served only if all pre-registered recipients do not pick up their commodities. In addition to the dry goods boxes, registered applicants may qualify for a supplemental fresh fruit and vegetable produce box if funding is available.
